Director Experience

I had the honour to be the Theatre Director for the play A Lie of the Mind (Mente Mentira, in portuguese), by Sam Shepard, in 2016.

My main objective as a Director was to focus on Shepard's text and identify the most important and universal issues that the play addresses. I found three essential pillars: family relationships, the ties that prevent us from moving on, and the lies that our minds come up with to stay away from (or to survive) our reality. With that in mind, I knew this western American story would resonate with the Brazilian audience.

With a very minimalistic set design of three tables of different sizes, and thanks to the work of very talented actors, we brought to life our own version of the play and were able to take the audience to all the places that the text proposes.

The play was shortlisted for the Arte Qualidade Brasil Award in the category of Best Drama Director.

In July 2020 the Swiss director Andrea Lavio and I directed the devised comedy piece *The Internship*.






